- Review of MORAA Carcass Show Incentives for Missouri State Fair
 - o Current Incentive
 - The Missouri Red Angus Association will award \$500 to the over-all Grand Champion "On-the-Rail" and \$250 for the over-all Reserve Champion "On-The-Rail" if the steer is a registered Red Angus. Additionally, \$500 will be awarded to the top placing and \$250 for the second top placing "On-The-Rail" carcass steers that are registered Red Angus, as well as exhibited by a 4-H or FFA exhibitor.
 - Potential Payout = \$1500

o Proposed Incentive

- The Missouri Red Angus Association will award \$500 to the Over-all Grand Champion "On-the-Rail" and \$250 for the over-all Reserve Champion "On-The-Rail" if the steer is a registered Red Angus.
- Potential Payouts
- \$750 (5% chance of occurrence)
- \$500 (10% chance of occurrence)
- \$250 (15% chance of occurrence)



o Other Proposed Options

Clint proposed- \$500 to top placing Red Angus carcass steer (must be 4-H or FFA member)

Bud give the top placing Red Angus steer \$400 and if it happens to be the champion overall give an extra \$100 for a total of \$500.

Jerry thinks that we need to do a better job promoting what we are sponsoring and the success no matter what we decide.

Linda \$250 to the Top Red Angus \$100 to the 2nd place Red Angus, if they happen to go on and be Grand or Reserve, they have a chance to double their money.
